**BEDSIDE MEMORIAL** A time for staff to gather with family in reflection, remembrance, and prayer for your loved one. This provides time for staff to reflect on their time serving your loved one and to grieve their loss of this special person for whom they provided the ministry of care and service in love.

**PROCESSION OF HONOR** is a time for any family, friends, and staff to honor your loved one as their body is removed from the home.
